

British Safety Council offer free health and safety qualification for all 14-19 Year olds

A young person is seriously injured in UK workplace every 40 minutes. In the last decade, 66 under-19's have been killed at work.

The British Safety Council will pay for all 14-19 year olds in full-time education to gain the BSC Entry Level Award in Workplace Hazard Awareness. This nationally recognised free qualification is designed to keep young people healthy and safe on work experience or in their first job.
